
Crane Aerospace and Electronics (AE) are making a change to our Crane AE ShareFile Supplier Portal that will further protect ShareFile content from unauthorized access. Going forward, Crane AE ShareFile Supplier Portal is only accessible after you have Multi-Factor Authenticated (MFA), meeting our DFARS requirements.

Enabling Two-Factor Authentication (2FA) means that anyone outside Crane AE will now be required to register for 2FA to access any content. Next time you log into ShareFile, you will be prompted to setup 2FA token using a mobile phone. You will be given the option to register your computer or device so that subsequent connections will not require 2FA.

These changes are being made to better protect the Intellectual Property stored on Crane AE ShareFile Supplier Portal and reduce the potential of unauthorized access.

The first time you log in with an external account, it will prompt for a phone number which will be used to send a text message to:
